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At its meeting of December 18-19 the Workers' Compensation Board of Directors:

- Received and approved a report from the Chair of the Governance and Policy Committee on discussion at the December 15th meeting of the Committee:
 - > The Committee received an update on meetings of the Occupational Health and Safety Advisory Council held in October and November.
 - > The Committee received the WCB Occupational Health and Safety Report for the quarter ended September 30th, 2014.
