



A change to the monthly benefit payment schedule:
 WCB monthly benefits issued on the first Wednesday of every month

You count on your workers' compensation benefits.

They are critical to you and your family. And, knowing when they'll arrive helps you plan your life. That's why we're making a change, so it's easy to understand, and the same every month.

How it works today:

- Benefits are issued by the WCB on a different day, early in each month.
- The calendar is published on the WCB website.
- It's not easy to remember exactly what date is the payment date.

What's changing?


- Beginning February 1, 2025, benefits will be issued by the WCB on the first Wednesday of every month.
- Benefits will be in your bank account 1 to 3 business days after this date, depending on your bank's processing times. These dates vary a little depending on your bank.
- No more wondering what the date is this month.



Q: When is my monthly benefit by WCB issued?

A: The first **Wednesday** of the month. You can expect to receive the payment in your bank account between 1 to 3 business days after this date, depending on your bank's processing times.

It's very rare that a holiday falls on a Wednesday, but sometimes they can. On these days, your payment would be issued on the **previous business day**.
