



Oracle Supplier Registration Portal Terms and Conditions

To register for the Oracle Supplier Registration Portal (the “Portal”) you are required to accept the Terms and Conditions below which shall govern your use of the Portal.

Introduction

You are about to register for the Portal and create an account in relation to a legal entity operating in a commercial capacity (the “Business”).

The Portal is offered to you by the Workers' Compensation Board of Nova Scotia (“WCB Nova Scotia”) as online platform that will allow the Business to receive purchase orders, submit invoices, review payment status thereof and make updates to supplier profile.

Registration and Access

By registering for the Portal, you are agreeing to these Terms and Conditions on behalf of yourself and the Business.

Accuracy of Information

You are responsible for ensuring that your registration and account information is complete, accurate and up to date. The WCB Nova Scotia is not liable for any loss or damage of any kind whatsoever that may arise from incorrect or incomplete information on the Portal. The WCB Nova Scotia may request corrections to your supplier record if it contains errors.

No Guarantee of Contract of Bid Opportunities

Registration in the Portal does not grant any special status or guarantee any contracts or sales with the WCB Nova Scotia, nor does it guarantee notification of any procurement opportunities. You are solely responsible for checking within the Portal for any updates posted, as applicable.

No Warranties and Limitation of Liability

The Portal is provided free of charge to users and, as such, is provided “as is” without warranty of any kind, express or implied, including warranty of fitness for a particular purpose. The WCB Nova Scotia does not represent or warrant:

- (a) The accuracy or the comprehensiveness of the Portal, or that the Portal will function without error, failure or interruption;
- (b) That the Portal is free of viruses or other harmful components.

You acknowledge on your own behalf and on behalf of the Business that the WCB Nova Scotia will not, under any circumstances, be liable for any loss or damage of any kind which may result from, arise out of, or in any way be related to your use of or registration to use the Portal, including without limitation, reliance on the functioning of the Portal. In no event shall the WCB Nova Scotia be liable for any damages of any nature or kind, including damages arising from actions based on negligence, contract, or any other cause of action, which arise out of result from, or in any way relate to the use of or inability to use the Portal.

Portal Monitoring and Misuse

The Portal is monitored by the WCB Nova Scotia. Any evidence of misuse or breach of these Terms and Conditions may result in the deactivation of your account.

Suspension or Termination

WCB Nova Scotia may discontinue the Portal or suspend or terminate use of the Portal at any time and for any reason, without any given notice.

Cookies

The Portal user acknowledges that Cookies may be used to gather information to enhance Portal experience and/or examine opportunities to improve user experience. These Cookies are not used to identify you personally.

Responsibility

You are responsible for securing your devices, web browsers and email inboxes. You are responsible to keep all registration details, including passwords, secure and will be responsible for any unauthorized access, collection, use and disclosure of personal information or other information that results from you not keeping your registration details confidential. It is recommended that you use an updated and secure browser; log out of the Portal after use; keep antivirus software up to date.

Any material posted on the Portal is owned by the WCB Nova Scotia or the public entity posting it. You may not use, copy or distribute the material except to prepare your response.

Jurisdiction and Governing Law

These Terms and Conditions are governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws in force in Nova Scotia, and you agree and submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts in Nova Scotia.
